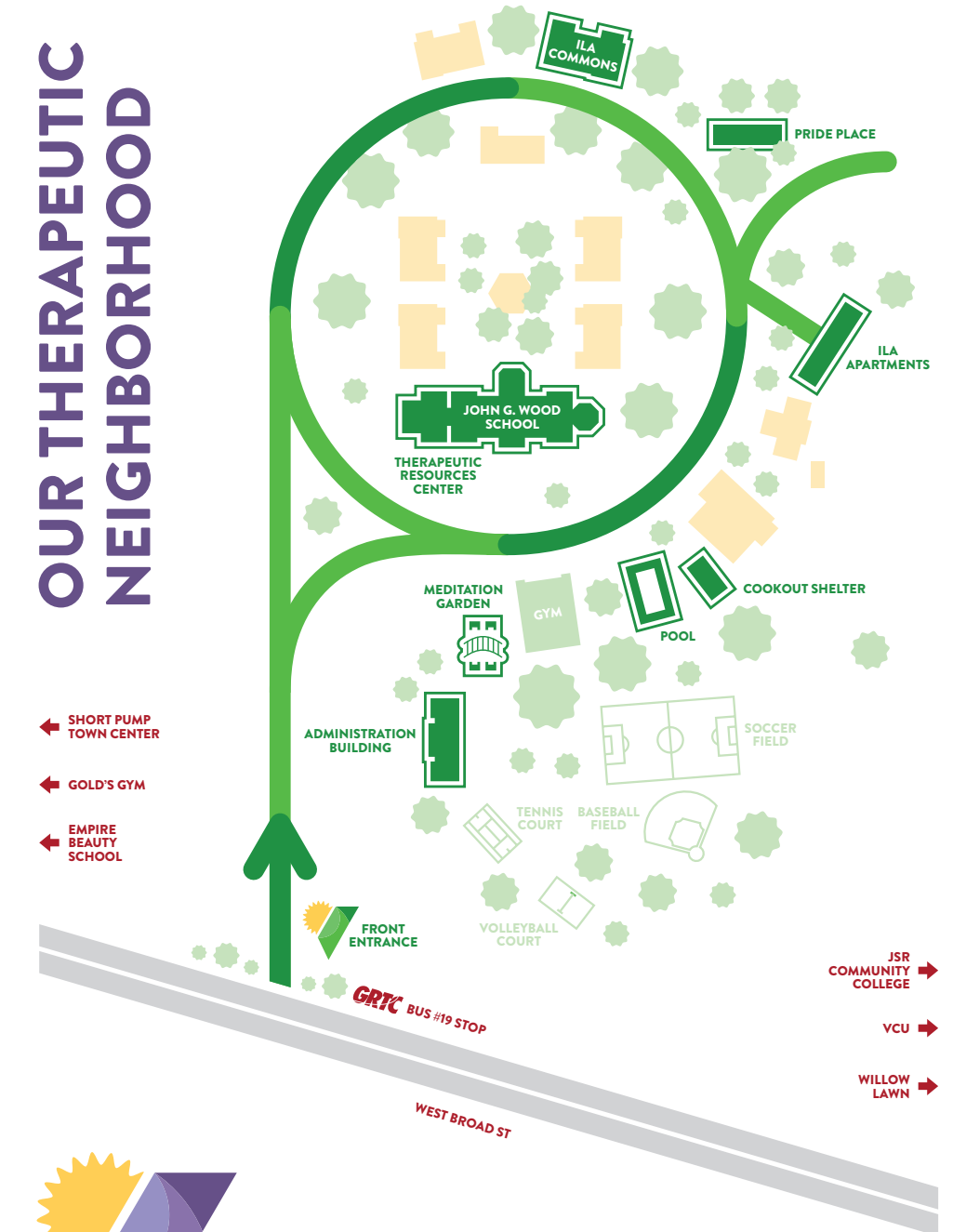


Just 10 minutes outside of Richmond City, our Independent Living program provides transformative housing and support services for young adults ages 17-21.
