GOALS

In the first seven days you will meet with your caseworker to set benchmark goals to achieve stable housing. Each benchmark achievement potentially allows for 30-day extensions as needed to find your stable housing.

ACCOMMODATIONS

This housing program is located on the busline in two brick homes on our 30 plus acre, park-like campus in the west end of Henrico County which is also the location for several other transitional living programs. These well-equipped homes include private bedrooms and bathrooms. The homes are fully furnished and equipped with necessities including bedding and kitchen gear.

SUPPORT

Rent and utilities are covered through grants, but all residents are responsible for their own personal needs including but not limited to food, medical care, and transportation. Your caseworker can support you in learning to access these resources if you do not have the financial means to secure these items.

VHBG is an affirming place to live and learn and has experience caring for young people who identify as LGBTQ+ and other marginalized populations. We're able to designate housing exclusively for LGBTQ+ people if needed and if available. This affinity group is called Pride Place at VHBG. We're also accepting of young people with multi-cultural backgrounds who speak different languages.
