Our outdoor SWIMMING POOL

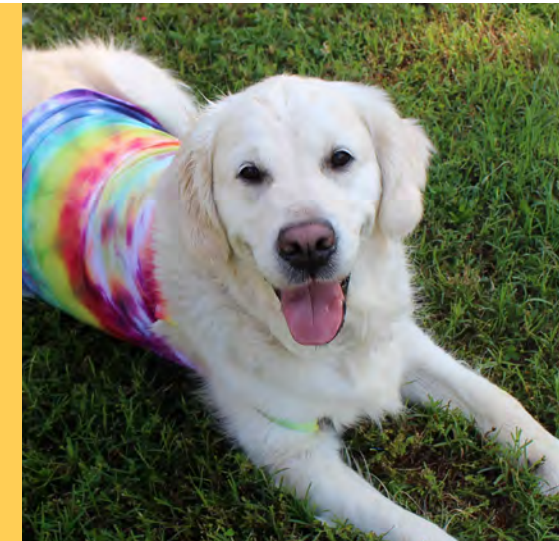
is fun in warm weather. It's used for swimming lessons and enjoyed during our yearly luau that includes a picnic, games, and a water slide.



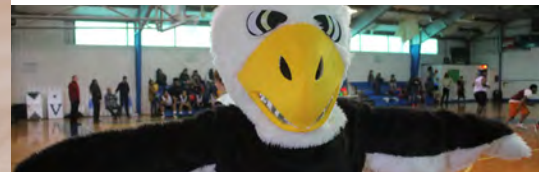
With a campus that includes more than 30 park-like acres, there's plenty of room for **FIELD DAY GAMES** and exciting sporting events.
